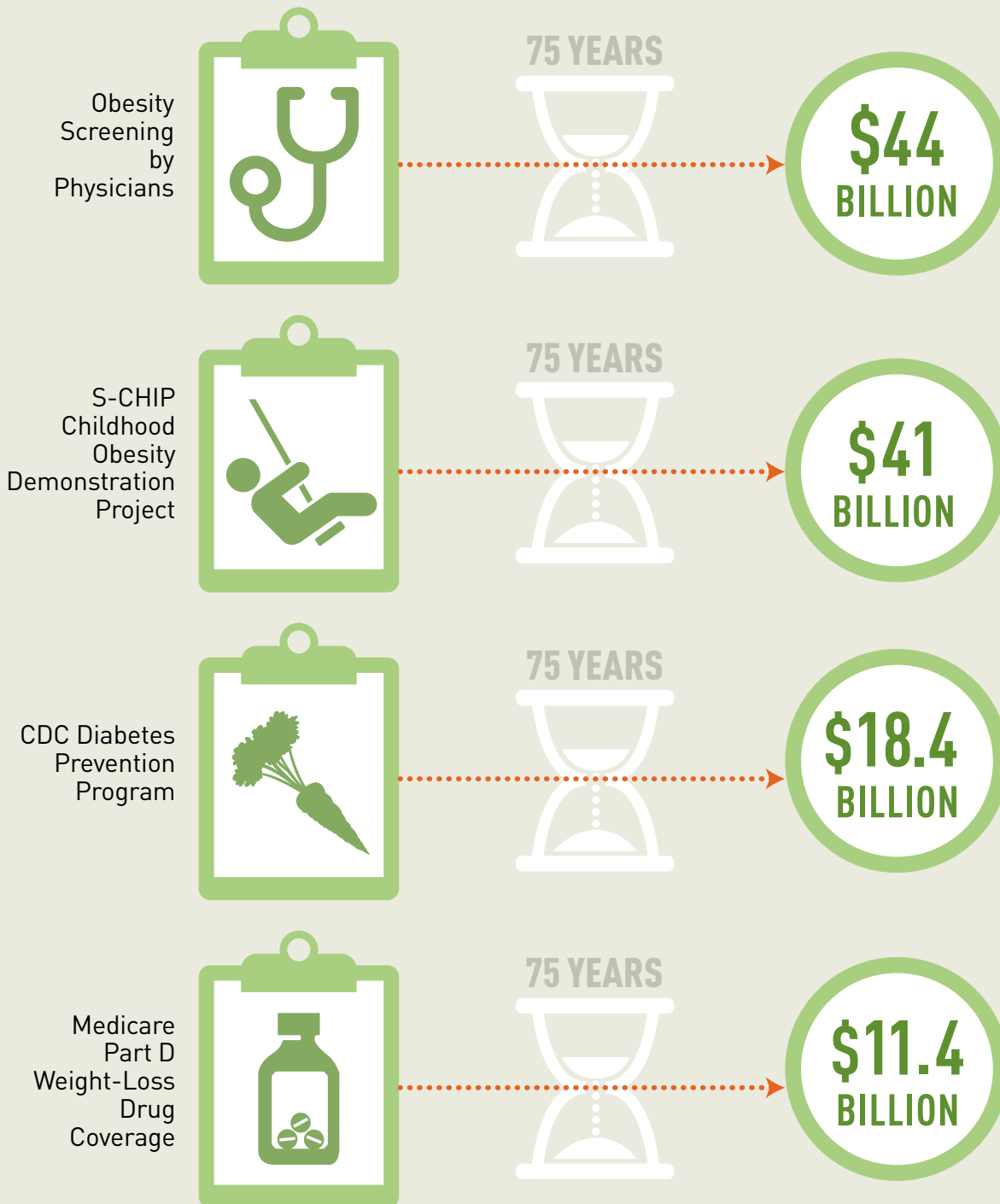


Federal Obesity-Prevention Efforts Could Save Billions of Dollars Over 75 Years
